The Board of Directors of Reinvestment Zone Number One, City of Katy, Texas (the "Zone"), will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, January 20, 2026, at 9:30 a.m., at Katy City Hall, 901 Avenue C, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive comments from the public.
2. Approve minutes of previous meeting.
3. Accountant's report, including authorize appropriate action regarding investments, as necessary.
4. Bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. accept annual disclosure statements of accountant/Investment Officers;
 - b. conduct annual review of Investment Policy and adopt Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy; and
 - c. review, revise and adopt Resolution Establishing Authorized Depository Institutions and Adopting List of Qualified Broker/Dealers with Whom the Zone May Engage in Investment Transactions.
5. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to (i) Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to seek the advice of its attorney regarding pending or contemplated litigation or to seek and receive legal advice by the Zone's attorney; and/or (ii) Section 551.087, Texas Government Code, to discuss economic development matters.
6. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding (i) pending or contemplated litigation or the legal advice by the Zone's attorney; and/or (ii) economic development matters.
7. Meeting schedule.
8. Any other business to come before the Board.
