
The Board of Directors of Katy Development Authority will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, February 17, 2026, at 3:00 p.m., at Katy City Hall, 901 Avenue C, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Comments from the public.
2. Approve minutes of previous meeting.
3. Accountant's report, including payment of bills and review of investments.
4. Metro Contract Revenue Bonds, Series 2026, including:
 - a. award sale of the District's Metro Contract Revenue Bonds, Series 2026;
 - b. approve Bond Purchase Agreement;
 - c. adopt Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of the Authority's Metro Contract Revenue Bonds, Series 2026;
 - d. approve Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement;
 - e. approve Official Statement;
 - f. execution of Certificate Regarding Provision of Financial Advice;
 - g. authorize the Board of Directors to sign all documents relating to the bond sale and authorize attorney and financial advisor to take all necessary action to deliver bonds to the purchaser; and
 - h. approve payment to Attorney General relating to bond issue transcript review.
5. City of Katy Engineer's report and authorize necessary action, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, award of contracts, approval of pay estimates and change orders, acceptance of projects, and approval of proposals as needed for the following:
 - a. Pitts Road at Morton Intersection Realignment and Traffic Signal Phase 2;
 - b. Morton Road widening, Pitts Road to Katy-Hockley Road;
 - c. Katy-Hockley Road widening from Morton Road to Clay Road;
 - d. Nelson Way Extension and Bridge;
 - e. Pin Oak Widening from Interstate 10 to Katy Flewellen;
 - f. Traffic Signal: Franz Road at Scott Ranch Road; and
 - g. Traffic Signal: Katy Hockley Cut-off Road at Heritage Drive.

Katy Development Authority reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above, as authorized by Texas Government Code, Section 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney about Pending or Contemplated Litigation), Section 551.072 (Deliberations about Real Property), Section 551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), Section 551.074 (Personnel Matters), Section 551.076 (Deliberations about Security Devices), and Section 551.087 (Economic Development).

 - a. Katy Boardwalk Entry Monument Study; and
 - b. Prairie Parkway East Streetscape Improvements.
