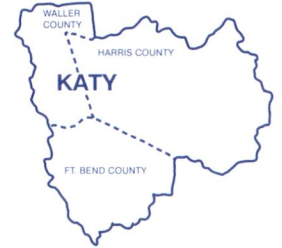

RESOLUTION NO. 1127



HUB CITY OF THREE COUNTIES

A RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KATY, TEXAS, REQUIRING ALL ELECTIONEERING SIGNS LOCATED AT ANY CITY FACILITY DESIGNATED AS A POLLING PLACE MUST BE NO LARGER THAN 18" X 24" AND NO MORE THAN 3 FEET HIGH FROM THE GROUND TO THE TOP OF THE SIGN AND SETTING A TIME PERIOD.

Whereas, section 61.003 (a-1) of the Texas Election Code provides that the entity that owns or controls a public building being used as a polling place may enact reasonable regulations concerning the time, place and manner of electioneering; and

Whereas, section 85.036 (b) of the Texas Election Code provides that the entity that owns or controls a public building being used as a polling place for early voting may enact reasonable regulations concerning the time, place and manner of electioneering; and

Whereas, sections 61.003 and 85.036 of the Texas Election Code include the posting use, or distribution of political signs or literature in the definition of electioneering.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KATY, TEXAS:


Section 1. That the City Council hereby orders that all electioneering signs located at any city facility designated as a polling place during the election period must be no larger than 18" X 24" and no more than 3 feet high from the ground to the top of the sign.

Section 2. That the City Council hereby orders that all electioneering signs as described under Section 1. not be erected earlier than 24 hours before the polls open for in-person voting at that location; and shall be removed within 48 hours of the last day of in-person voting at that polling location.


Section 3. That the City Council hereby orders this resolution become effective January 1, 2021.


